APPLICATION

Applications to our university will be made **online**. Applications by mail will not be accepted. Candidates whose situations meet any of the following can apply to the appropriate category in the international student quota in SBTÜ's associate and undergraduate programs for the 2026-2027 academic year.

A. WHO CAN APPLY?

Foreign national candidates applying to associate and undergraduate degree programs must be in their final year of high school or have already graduated. Provided that they meet this condition, applications will be accepted from:

1. **Foreign nationals:** *(Provided they have not studied at or graduated from high schools in Turkey. Exceptions apply to foreign nationals who completed their entire high school education in Embassy schools or international private educational institutions registered in the MOBİS system, as well as foreign nationals brought to Turkey within the framework of projects conducted by the Ministry of National Education or the Council of Higher Education).*
2. **Former Turkish Citizens/Blue Card Holders:** Individuals who were Turkish citizens by birth but lost their citizenship by obtaining permission to renounce it from the Ministry of Interior, and those who can document that they hold a Blue Card issued upon request to those who lost their Turkish citizenship. *(Provided they have not studied at or graduated from high schools in Turkey and the TRNC. Candidates applying for international admission quotas are advised to review Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901).*
3. **Naturalized Turkish Citizens / Dual Citizens:** Foreign nationals who later acquired Turkish citizenship, and dual citizens in this status. *(Provided they have not studied at or graduated from high schools in Turkey and the TRNC).*
4. **Turkish Citizens Educated Abroad:** Turkish citizens who completed their entire secondary (high school) education in a foreign country, excluding the TRNC. *(This includes those who completed their entire high school education in Turkish schools opened by the Ministry of National Education [MEB] in a foreign country other than the TRNC).*
5. **TRNC Citizens:** Citizens of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) who hold GCE AL, TR-YÖS, or meet the criteria specified in the application and admission directives of higher education institutions approved by the Council of Higher Education. *(Provided they have not studied at or graduated from high schools in Turkey or high schools in the TRNC that apply the Turkish curriculum).*

B. WHO CANNOT APPLY?

Candidates whose situations match any of the following criteria are ineligible to apply for the international student admission quotas. Applications will **not** be accepted from candidates who are:

1. **Turkish Citizens** who completed their entire secondary (high school) education in Turkey or the TRNC.
2. **TRNC Citizens or dual citizens whose one nationality is TRNC**, who completed their secondary education in high schools in Turkey or in high schools in the TRNC that apply the Turkish curriculum.
3. **Dual Citizens whose first nationality by birth is Turkish**, as defined in Article 7 of the

Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 (except for those who meet the conditions specified in clause 4 of Section A).

4. **Turkish Citizens or dual citizens whose first nationality by birth is Turkish** (as defined in Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901), who studied at schools affiliated with foreign embassies in Turkey or foreign high schools located in Turkey.
5. **Individuals in the following categories:**
 - a) TRNC citizens, individuals who renounced Turkish citizenship, or Blue Card holders who studied at or graduated from secondary (high school) education institutions in Turkey and the TRNC.
 - b) Foreign nationals who studied at or graduated from high schools in Turkey. (Excluding foreign nationals who completed their entire high school education in Embassy schools or international private educational institutions registered in the MOBİS system, as well as foreign nationals brought to Turkey within the framework of projects conducted by the Ministry of National Education or the Council of Higher Education).

C. TYPES OF APPLICATION

Candidates who meet the application requirements can apply to SBTU international student admission with only one application type in the appropriate category among the application types listed in the table below.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION

Applicants must upload scanned copies of the documents listed below to the system when applying online

- TR-YÖS Result Certificate or result certificate of exams with University Entrance Exam status,
- Original High School Diploma and School Recognition Certificate (Turkish or English translation must be presented at the time of registration.)
- Photocopy of Passport or Turkish Republic Identity Card/Blue Card. (Must be presented together with the original.)
- 1 biometric photograph. (Must be taken within the last 6 months and be easily identifiable.)
- Transcript (High school/secondary education graduation diplomas or transcripts must include a statement showing the "High School Diploma Grade.")

EVALUATION

HOW ARE APPLICATIONS EVALUATED?

Candidates who apply to SBTÜ associate's degree-undergraduate programs for the 2026-2027 academic year from the international student quota are subject to a two-stage evaluation process within the framework of the steps listed below.

Preliminary Evaluation of Applications

- a) All candidates are evaluated according to the "Application Type" they applied for. The application status of candidates who do not submit documents appropriate to the application type will be changed to "Incorrect/Incomplete Document".
- b) The application status of candidates who upload their documents completely to the system will be changed to "Approved".
- c) The application status of candidates whose applications do not meet the conditions stated above will be changed to "Rejected".
- d) After the application status changes, candidates will send the message "Your application status has changed" to their e-mail addresses provided in the form. Information is sent in the form of . It is the candidates' responsibility to follow the application status in the "Online Application System" and pay attention to the relevant warnings in the explanation section.

Evaluation of Applications

Evaluation of the applicants is carried out by the relevant units, the Overseas Student Evaluation Commission established by the Senate and the Student Affairs Department.

- 1) Order of priority in the evaluation of applications; TR-YÖS exam conducted by ÖSYM is carried out in line with the principles determined by the University Senate, taking into account the results of the National and/or International Exams of Countries with the status of University entrance exam, exams with the status of High School graduation exam and High School Diploma Grades.
- 2) Candidates can choose a maximum of 3 programs. Placement is done according to the conditions of the program preferred by the candidates.
- 3) The scores of students with different achievement score types are converted into a hundred (100) system and evaluated.
- 4) Meeting the application conditions does not require placement.
- 5) In case of equality of points in placements, candidates' secondary school achievement grades are taken into account.
- 6) Applications of candidates who do not meet the application requirements or have missing documents will not be evaluated.

- 7) If necessary, the University may make additional placements among programs for which applications have not been made or whose quotas have not been filled.
- 8) Candidates who were placed in a program in the first placement cannot apply for additional placement.
- 9) Candidates who meet the application requirements are ranked according to their scores and placed in the relevant programs according to their preferences. Candidates with dual citizenship must state their preferred citizenship information when filling out the application form.
- 10) After the registration process at SBTÜ is completed, it is at the discretion of SBTÜ to make additional placements in the vacant quotas due to the candidates who are entitled to enroll in the programs not registering or the programs not being filled, and to change the evaluation criteria in these placements.

TURKISH

Language of instruction; In programs in Turkish, for candidates to certify their Turkish language proficiency before registration; **B2** level Turkish language proficiency certificates obtained in the last two years from Turkish education centers accepted by YÖK will be valid. Candidates with the said documents have the right to start the relevant program directly if they are accepted.

A student who is enrolled in a program whose language of instruction is Turkish and whose Turkish is insufficient is considered to be on leave from the program for one year in order to make his Turkish proficiency in the "TOMER Turkish Preparatory Program". If the student cannot reach a sufficient level of Turkish language within this period, an additional time is given for one year of Turkish Preparation. The student who is deemed to be on leave pays the tuition fee of the program in which he/she is registered. At the end of the additional period, the student who cannot make his/her Turkish level sufficient is deleted from the program in which he/she is registered.

If the candidates who do not have Turkish language proficiency at B2 level are accepted, they will be able to receive training in Turkish preparatory courses conducted at the Turkish Teaching Application and Research Center (TOMER).
