APPLICATION

Applications to the Sivas University of Science and Technology can be made online or face to face. Applications via e-mail will not be accepted. Alternate whose conditions match any of the following can apply to the appropriate category in the international student quota in undergraduate programs of SBTU for the 2022-2023 academic year.

1. WHO CAN APPLY?

Provided that foreign national Candidates who will apply to undergraduate programs are in the last year of high school or have graduated;

(1) Foreign national students,

(2) Those who are Turkish citizens by birth but lose their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission from the Ministry of Internal Affairs to renounce their Turkish citizenship, and those who certify that they have a blue card, which is given upon request to those who lost their Turkish citizenship, (Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 “(1) within Turkey or A child born in a marriage union with a Turkish citizen mother or father outside the country is a Turkish citizen.”, it is useful for Candidates who will apply for admission quotas from abroad to examine the Turkish Citizenship Law.)

(3) Citizenship acquired later while being a foreign national and T.C. naturalized / dual citizens in this situation

(4)*a) If Turkish students continue his secondary education abroad before 01/02/2013, among the citizens, those who completed the last three years of their secondary education (high school) in a foreign country excluding the TRNC (including those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a Turkish school opened by the Ministry of National Education in a foreign country other than the TRNC) can apply for the quota for student admission from abroad.

b) Applicant who started secondary education abroad after 01/02/2013 can apply to the admission quota from abroad, including those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a foreign country excluding the TRNC (including those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a Turkish school opened by the Ministry of National Education in a foreign country other than the TRNC),

(5) TRNC citizens; Accepting the applications of those who reside in the TRNC and have completed their secondary education (high school) in the TRNC, and have GCE AL exam results, and those who have or will have GCE AL exam results by enrolling in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010,

2. WHO CANNOT APPLY?

Those who face any of the following conditions cannot apply for the international student admission quota.

(1) Those who are Turkish citizens and have completed all of their secondary education

(high school) in Turkey or the TRNC,

(2) TRNC citizens (except those who have completed their entire secondary education (high school) in TRNC high schools and have GCE AL results, and those who have or will have GCE AL exam results by registering and studying at colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010),

(3) One whose first nationality by birth is T.C., as defined in article 2 under the heading "Who Can Apply", dual citizens (except for those who meet the conditions in clause 4 of article 5)

(4) Dual citizens, one of them is TRNC nationality (except those who have completed their secondary education (high school) in TRNC high schools and have GCE AL results, and those who have or will have GCE AL exam results by enrolling in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010),

(5) Applications of dual citizens who are Turkish citizens or whose first nationality is Turkish by birth as defined in clause 2 of article a, who have studied at schools affiliated to the embassies in Turkey and foreign high schools in Turkey, are not accepted.

3. TYPES OF APPLICATION

Candidates who meet the application requirements can apply to SBTU international student admission with only one application type in the appropriate category among the application types listed in the table below.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION

Candidates should have scanned documents ready to upload to the system during online application.

- a) YÖS result document or result document of exams that has University Entrance Examination Status.
- b) Original High School Diploma and School Recognition Certificate (Must be translated into Turkish).
- c) Passport or copy of TC ID Card/Blue Card (To be submitted along with the originals).
- ç) 2 biometric photos (Should be taken within the last six months and should identify the candidate easily).
- d) Grade Status Document (Transcript). There should be a phrase showing the High School Diploma Grade on the diplomas or transcripts.

CAUTION! Online Application System is going to close on July 31, 2022 at 23.59 Turkish Time.

Evaluation of Applications

Evaluation procedures of the Candidates are made by the relevant academic units, the Foreign Student Admissions Commission formed by the Senate and the Registrar's Office.

- (1) The order of priority in the evaluation of applications; The YÖS exam given by Universities in Turkey is carried out in accordance with the principles determined by the University Senate, taking into account the results of the National and/or International Exams of the Countries with the status of the University Entrance Exam, the exams with the status of High School Graduation Exam and the High School Diploma Grades.
- (2) Candidates can choose a maximum of 3 programs. Placement is done according to the conditions of the program preferred by the candidates.
- (3) The scores of students with different achievement score types are converted into a hundred (100) system and evaluated.
- (4) Meeting the application conditions does not require placement.
- (5) In case of equality of ranking points in the placements, first the preference order of the candidates and then the secondary school success grades are taken into consideration.
- (6) Applications of candidates who do not meet the application requirements or with missing documents will not be evaluated.
- (7) Additional placements can be made by the University among the programs for which applications are not made or the quotas are not filled.
- (8) Candidates placed in a program in the first placement cannot apply for additional placement.
- (9) Candidates who meet the application requirements are ranked according to their scores and placed in the relevant programs according to their preferences. Candidates with dual citizenship

must state their preferred citizenship information when filling out the application form.
(10) It is at the discretion of SBTU to make additional placements for the vacant quotas and to change the evaluation criteria for these placements due to the fact that the candidates who are entitled to enroll in the programs do not enroll in the programs after the registration process is completed or the programs are not filled.

1. EDUCATION - LANGUAGE OF TEACHING

The language of instruction of the programs applied to at our university is 100% English and Turkish.

Turkish

Language of instruction; In programs in Turkish, for candidates to certify their Turkish language proficiency before registration; B2 level Turkish language proficiency certificates

obtained in the last two years from Turkish education centers accepted by YÖK will be valid. Candidates with the said documents have the right to start the relevant program directly if they are accepted.

A student who is enrolled in a program whose language of instruction is Turkish and whose Turkish is insufficient is considered to be on leave from the program for one year in order to make his Turkish proficiency in the "TOMER Turkish Preparatory Program". If the student cannot reach a sufficient level of Turkish language within this period, an additional time is given for one year of Turkish Preparation. The student who is deemed to be on leave pays the tuition fee of the program in which he/she is registered. At the end of the additional period, the student who cannot make his/her Turkish level sufficient is deleted from the program in which he/she is registered.

If the candidates who do not have Turkish language proficiency at B2 level are accepted, they will be able to receive training in Turkish preparatory courses conducted at the Turkish Teaching Application and Research Center (TOMER).
